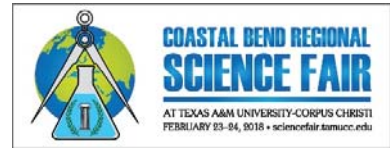


# District project entry guidelines



Effective November 1, 2017, districts can now maximize their number of projects by combining their number of entries across grade levels within the same division, based on the district's average daily attendance (ADA), as follows:

- **Grades K–5** can enter a maximum number of projects by grade, according to the key below. For example, a district with 0–2,000 students can enter 5 projects from each grade.
- **Grades 6–8** can combine their maximum number of entries across grade levels, according to the key below. For example, a district with 0–2,000 students can enter a total of 15 projects for grades 6–8, even if certain grades enter more than 5 projects and other grades enter fewer than 5.
- **Grades 9–12** can also combine their maximum number of entries across grade levels, according to the key below. For example, a district with 0–2,000 students can enter a total of 20 projects for grades 9–12, even if certain grades enter more than 5 projects and other grades enter fewer than 5.
